POLICE CIRCULAR ORDER NO. 286 /1998.

Repeated instances have come to notice that officers/men transferred are shown relieved at the first instance and after lapse of considerable time are physically relieved. This is an un-healthy practice not supported by any Rule or Instruction of the Government. Such practice is causing serious dislocation in its administrative aspect. Police Order No.79 and para-7 and 8 of Book Circular Order No. 42 provide that a Government servant transferred should be relieved within 7 days and there is no provision for showing a Government servant relieved on paper and physically relieving him on a subsequent date. This practice must be stopped henceforth. Any deviation in this regard shall be adversely viewed.
