Publication of gradation list of Sub- Inspector of Police.

The following criteria/ Rules have been adopted while preparing the
gradation list of Sub-Inspectors of Police.

- (1) Home Department Resolution No. 22543/D&A dt. 27.5.06 (Gazette
publication dt. 8.6.06).

Rule-27(1)- The inter-se-seniority of Sub-Inspectors appointed by
way of direct recruitment during a particular recruitment year shall be
determined in the order of the names appears in the select list.

Rule-27(2)- All the persons appointed to the rank of Sub-Inspector
of Police by way of promotion shall be assigned relative position as per
the approved select list, but they shall in block be senior to all the Sub-
Inspectors appointed during the year by way of direct recruitment.

Besides, the seniority of Sub-Inspectors are being maintained in
order of position assigned to them provided they pass in the training examination
at BPSPA successfully as per the existing practice. Further, as per Home Deptt.
letter No. 43954/D&A dt. 25.9.10, the preparation of gradation list shall be only
after passing out of S.I.'s training course as per the judgement of Hon'ble Apex
court.

- (2) Home Department Resolution No. 22706/D&A dt. 18.5.10 (Gazette
Publication dt. 31.5.10).

Rule-2(1) Not withstanding anything contained in the Odisha
Staff Selection Rules-1993, the direct recruit Sub-Inspectors shall be ranked
inter-se in order of merit which shall be determined in accordance with the
aggregate marks obtained by each probationer.

- (a) At the competitive examination conducted by the Commission, and
 - (b) At the final examination conducted by BPSPA, Bhubaneswar.

Provided that if two or more probationers have secured equal number of marks in the aggregate, their order of merit shall be the order of their date of birth.


Keeping in view the above rules and instructions of Government, the gradation list of eligible Sub-Inspectors have been prepared after their passing out at Training Institutions batch wise. Those who were failed in the first instance, they allowed to appear the supplementary examination with the next batch. Their names have not come with the first instance candidates. Their names have been found place above to the next batch CSIs with whom they appear and pass the training examination.

Only Odisha Staff Selection Commission mark have been taken in to account in respect of Sub-Inspectors as per Home Department Resolution No.22543/D&A dtd.27.05.2006 those who have passed out after issue of above Resolution and before issue of Home Department Resolution No.22706/D&A dtd.18.05.2010.

Similarly Odisha Staff Selection Commission mark, plus BPSPA mark have been taken in to account in respect of Sub-Inspectors of Police while preparing the gradation list as per Home Department Resolution No.22706/D&A dtd.18.05.2010, those who have passed out after issue of above Resolution.

Prior to publication of Cadre Rule, 2006 of S.Is., the inter-seniority has been prepared basing on the result of the training centre batch wise after passing out.
