
Officer oriented Policy – Provision of Inspector, in charge for important Police Stations and Dy. S.P. for all Circles in the interest of public service – upgradation of posts.

Sir,

In inviting a reference to your letter No.33367/Force dated 28.1.2007 on the subject cited above, I am directed to say that Government after careful consideration of the proposal has been pleased to upgrade 183 posts of Inspector of Police to that of Deputy Superintendent of Police, 307 posts of Sub-Inspector of Police to Inspector of Police and 1507 posts of Constables to that of Asst. Sub-Inspector of Police of various establishment / organization of Home (Police) Department.

It has been further stipulated that the State Police Headquarters shall not come up for creation of 1536 posts of Constables in future on administrative exigency and functional reasons in view of such upgradation or else the savings shown will be a temporary phenomena. The Man power strength of Constables incorporated in the yardstick in Thanas and other organizations should either be revised or Constables should appropriately be deployed reducing such strength from other secondary establishments.
