C. Pigeon service

The Pigeon Inspector/Sub-Inspector are placed under the administrative control of S. P., Signals and the latter will be responsible for the training and efficiency of the Pigeon Service.

- 1. Selection of pigeon constables .. S. P., Signals
- 2. Inter-district transfers .. D. I.-G., Tech.
- 3. Leave and C. L., if relief is required from outside district .. S. P., Signals otherwise S. P.
- 4. Way and travelling allowance, clothing, pension, By S. P., Signals maintenance of Service Books.
- 5. Rewards and punishments .. By S. P., Signals and S. P.
[S. P., Signals will exercise his powers of punishment on district staff through (Ss. P).]

6. Pigeon registers will continue to be maintained in the District Reserve Office under the supervision and inspection of pigeon S. I. and S. P., Signals.

It should be the endeavour of the S. P., Signals to work in harmony and close co-operation with the Ss. P. If however, any difference of opinion arises between the S. P., Signals and S. P. the matter will be referred to the D. I.-G., Tech. for decision.
