

POLICE ORDER No. 61

Prohibition of free admittance of police officers to places of entertainments. The practice of police officers accepting free passes or tickets and visiting places of entertainments without buying a ticket, still prevails in this Province. This is a corrupt practice and must be put a stop to immediately. Superintendents of Police are requested to bring this order to the notice of all their subordinate officers and deal severely with any infringements of this orders. The exception made of officers on duty should not be treated as giving to police officers a general permission to visit place of entertainments without buying tickets, places of the exemption is limited to visits made mainly in the discharge of duty.
