Sub: Creation of posts for establishment of 29 (twenty nine) Special Police Stations (Energy) for the purpose of registration, investigation, charge-sheeting, etc. of the offences punishable under Electricity Act, 2003.

Sir,

I am directed to convey the sanction of the Governor for creation of the following 522 (five hundred twenty two) posts of different categories for Special Police Stations (Energy) at places mentioned in column 2 in the table below with usual D.A. and other allowances as admissible from time to time with effect from the date the posts are actually filled up.

The Distribution Companies will recruit 29 Assistant Drivers and 29 Follower Orderlies in consultation with the Director General and Inspector General of Police. The Distribution Companies will pay the remuneration of Assistant Drivers and Follower Orderlies. The Police Uniform as required for those personnel will be provided by the Director General of Police and the cost of such uniform will be reimbursed by the Distribution Companies.

The Director General of Police will fill up all the posts of Inspectors, Assistant Sub-Inspectors and Havildars for Special Police Stations (energy) by way of promotion or re-deployment from the existing Police personnel of Police Organisation. The posts of Sub-Inspector of Police and Constable will be filled up through direct recruitment. In such direct recruitment cases, they will be governed by the new Pension Schemes introduced with effect from 01.01.2005. The Director General of Police will nominate an I.G. of Police/Additional Director General of Police from the Police Organisation to supervise the work of Special Police Stations (energy) for the present.

The entire cost of expenditure such as salary, non-salary, pension contribution, etc. of Police personnel engaged in 34 Special Police Stations (Energy) will be deposited by the Distribution companies in Government Account under the Head of Account "0055-Police-800-Other Receipts-0097-Miscellaneous Receipts-02082-Miscellaneous Other Receipts" in quarterly advance. A clear and written commitment should be obtained from the Distribution Companies by the Energy Department on re-imbursement of recurring and non-recurring cost of expenditure on opening and operating those Special Police Stations (Energy) so that there will be no liability to State Exchequer.

The charge is debitable to "Demand No.1-2055-Police-Non-Plan-109-District Police-0003050-District Organisation" in the Budget Estimate 2007-08.
