 - (ii) Police Order 1/1959 ... Read 'Superintendent of Police, C. I. D., C. B., Orissa, Cuttack, in place of 'D. I.-G. of Police, C. I. D., Bihar, Patna' occurring in Cols. 3 and 4 of Sl. 9 of the Order.
 - (iii) Police Order 2/1960 Read 'D.I.-G. of Police, M. P. & T.' in place of "D.I.-G. of Police, C. R.' occurring in the Order.
 - (iv) Police Order 9/1961 .. Read 'D. I.-G., M. P. & T., in place of 'D. I.-G., C. R.,' occurring in the Order.
- 3. The annual consecutive numbers allotted to the existing Police Orders since 1936 are hereby cancelled and they are numbered from 2 to 200 respectively. Fresh Police Orders which would be issued hereafter will bear chronological numbers after Police Order No. 200. These Orders should be removed from the *Police Gazette*, cut to size and placed in this book seriatum. The Index should similarly be cut and pasted at the relevant places in the index pages of the book.

During inspections of the posts, the Inspecting Officers should invariably look to this item of the work and ensure that this is maintained properly.
