

POLICE ORDER No. 130

Instruction in respect of conviction under the Untouchability (Offence) Act. Offences under the P. C. R. Act are cognizable ones. Section 1 of the Act prescribes for enhanced punishment for the second and subsequent offences. Therefore, in the event of a conviction the Court Officer concerned shall enter the conviction in the Conviction Register and treat the convict as a P. R. Prisoner and his finger print, shall be taken for record. Action is being taken to amend the relevant P. M. Rule.

The above procedure will be strictly followed and slackness or omission will be very seriously viewed and dealt with.
