POLICE ORDER No. 131

Conduct of departmental point through appeal petitions, memorials and representations, etc., it has come to proceedings my notice that departmental proceedings drawn up aginst Sub-Inspectors and equivalent ranks against Sub-have been entrusted, sometimes, to Inspectors and equivatlent ranks for enquiry. This procedure Inspectors of is not desirable. It is, therefore, ordered that departmental proceedings drawn up against Sub-Inspectors and equivalent ranks and above should invariably be conducted by Gazetted Officers only. In cases where the dismissal of an Officer of the status of Sub-Inspector is likely the proceedings should ordinarily be conducted by the Superintendent of Police himself, unless for good reason, such as owing to the remoteness of the place it is really necessary to depute some other Gazetted Officer to examine the witnesses on the spot or to make personal investigations in the locality.
