

POLICE ORDER No. 157

investigation by officers of Delhi Special Police Establishment.

Whereas under Government of India, Ministry of Home Affairs, Order No. 55/646-Police, dated the 1st October 1946, made under sub-section (1) of Section 5 of the Delhi Special Police Establishment Act, 1946 (25 of 1946), the powers and jurisdiction of the members of the Delhi Special Police Establishment extend to the area within the State of Orissa for the investigation of offences or class of offences specified in Government of India, Ministry of Home Affairs, Notification No.7/5/55-ADV. dated the 6th November 1956 as amended from time to time issued under section 3 of the said Act.

And whereas under sub-section (2) of the said section 5, a member of the said Police Establishment while discharging the functions of a police officer in the said area is to be deemed to be a member of the police force of the said area and be vested with the powers, functions and privileges and be subject to the liabilities of a police officer belonging to the police force of the said area.

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 4 of the...Police Act, 1861 (5 of 1861) I, the Inspector-General of Police, Orissa do hereby direct that whenever member of the Delhi Special Police Establishment of or above the rank of Sub-Inspector investigates at any place in the said area, any offence specified in Government of India Ministry of Home Affairs, Notification No. 7/5/55-ADV., dated the 6th November 1956, as amended from time to time issued under section 3 of the Delhi Special Police Establishment Act, 1946, he shall be deemed to be an officer attached to the police-station within the limits of which such place is situated.
