POLICE ORDER No. 197

Register of Rewards.

In the existing rules of the Orissa Police Manual, there is provision to maintain record of punishments awarded to different police personnel in a separate register, but no record of rewards is being kept except in the service books and the District Order Book where from it is very difficult to pick up particulars of rewards when required. As in the case of punishments, details of rewards are also necessary for statistical purposes and also for purposes to check when in a particular case complaint is received that rewards granted to an officer or man has been entered in the Service Book.

It is, therefore, ordered that a Register of Rewards granted to the police personnel shall be maintained in the Reserves Offices of all Districts/Establishments and the O.M.P. in the following *Pro forma*, with immediate effect. Superior Officers in course of their inspections of Reserve Offices must ensure that the Register is properly maintained.
