Discontinuance of Whitie Dril Coates issued to Traffic Havildar and Constables and introduction of white Drill half Slelve Shirts for Traffic police men. The introduction of a new pattern of white shirt in uniform for Traffic Havildars and Constables of Orissa Police was under consideration for sometime past with a view to facilitate clear and easy signalling and for better turn out the white drill coat now used by the Traffic Havildars and Constable of this State should be discontinued and white drill have half sleeve shirts introduced as per specifications given below :—

Shirts (Short Sleeve White Drill)—White drill with two brest patch pockets with a button flap each open neck with colar (To be worn without tie). Short sleeves, button holes three to fasten the shirt, two shoulder streps with button holes, two eyelets on each of the shoulder starp $1\frac{1}{2}$ apart from the point of shoulder.
