Sub: Revision of Compassionate Grant allowed to the State Government employees/ personnel who are victims of LWE violence.

Compassionate Grant to the Police Personnel, Forest Personnel, Home Guards, Grama Rakhis, Special Police Personnel as well as other categories of State Government employees suffering casualty or injury in the extremist violence while working in the Naxal affected areas of the State is sanctioned as per provisions of Orissa Civil Services (Compassionate Grant) Rules, 1964 read with Finance Department Resolution No. Pen-64/2001-53885/F., dated 02.11.2001, Resolution No. Pen-64/2000 (pt)-52349/F., dated 11.012.2003, Resolution No, Pen-61/2004 (Pt) - 41781/F., dated 24.09.2004, Resolution No. Pen- 144/2008-43870/F., dated 25.09.2008, Resolution No. Pen-73/2008-2510/F., dated 12.01.2009 and Resolution No. Pen-6/2010-35494/F., dated 17.08.2010. The matter regarding revision of prevailing compensation package of the State Government to the Personnel who are the victims of the Naxal violence was under active consideration of Government.

After careful consideration of all the aspects of the issue and in partial modification, of the above stated Resolutions, Government have been pleased to decide that the rates of compassionate grant for both police personnel and other categories of employees working in the Naxalite

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affected areas of the State who die or sustain injury on duty during extremist violence, will be revised as below.
