No. HOME-DAI-RULE-0243-2017/49442 Dated, Bhubaneswar, the

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 2 of the Police Act, 1861 (5 of 1861), the State Government do hereby make the following rules further to amend the Method of Recruitment of Conditions of Service of Sepoys/Constables in Battalions Rules, 2011, namely:-

1. (1) These rules may be called the Method of Recruitment and Conditions of Service of Sepoys/Constables in Battalions Amendment Rules, 2017
(2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Odisha gazette.
2. In the method of Recruitment and Conditions of Service of Sepoys/Constables Rules, 2011, in rule-12,-----

(a) for sub rule, 2 the following sub rule shall be substituted, namely:-

"2. Physical measurement for all categories: Height, weight and chest shall be measured to determine the eligibility. Marks for height shall be awarded in following manner.

(Allotted Marks- 20 Marks)

For General/SEBC (Men) Candidates

Below 168 cm	Disqualified
168 to 171 cm	10 Marks
Above 171 to 174 cm	12 Marks
Above 174 to 177 cm	14 Marks
Above 177 to 180 cm	16 Marks
Above 180 to 183 cm	18 Marks
Above 183 cm	20 Marks

For SC/ST (Men) Candidates

Below 163 cm	Disqualified
163 to 166 cm	10 Marks
Above 166 to 169 cm	12 Marks
Above 169 to 172 cm	14 Marks
Above 172 to 175 cm	16 Marks
Above 175 to 178 cm	18 Marks
Above 178 cm	20 Marks

If the candidate does not qualify in any of the physical standard, i.e. (height/weight/chest), he shall not be allowed to appear in further recruitment process."

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(b) in sub rule,3 in shoulder heading thereof for the words and figures "Written Test: Allotted Marks 25 (Twenty five)" the following words and figures shall be substituted namely:-

"Written Test: Allotted Marks 35 (Thirty Five)".

(c) in sub rule,4 the existing provisions shall be numbered as clause (a) and after clause (a) so numbered the following clause shall be added, namely:-

"(b) The applicant shall produce a **self-certificate** regarding his/her physical fitness declaring that he/she is fit to participate in different physical efficiency tests and submit it to the recruiting Board while appearing for the physical tests."

(d) for sub rule, 5 the following rule shall be substituted, namely:-

"5. Physical Efficiency Test (PET): (all category) Allotted marks- 35:

The Physical Efficiency Tests shall comprise of the following events with marks indicated against each

(a) Run: 1.6 Km, if covered within:-	5 minutes	..10 marks
	5 minutes 30 seconds	..7 marks
	6 minutes	..4 marks
	Beyond 6 minutes	.. Disqualified"

(b) High Jump (3 Chances) qualifying height 1.22 meters

If cleared in 3 chances 5 Marks
Not able to clear Disqualified

Note: Only those who qualify high jump of 1.22 Meters shall be allowed to compete to jump 1.38 Meters in single chance. Only those candidates, who qualify 1.38 Meters, shall be given to compete for 1.50 Meters in single chance. Higher marks shall be awarded as follows:

If cleared 1.38 Meters	:	7 Marks
If cleared 1.50 Meters	:	10 marks

Note: Marks shall be awarded only for the highest jump cleared."

"(c) Swimming : (40 Meters) (Qualifying)
If covered within 8 minutes : Qualified
Beyond 8 minutes : Disqualified."

"(d) Cross Country: 5 km, Allotted Marks: 15
If covered within 20 minutes : 15 marks
23 minutes : 10 marks
25 minutes : 05 marks
Beyond 25 minutes : Disqualified."

(c) for sub-rule,6 the following sub rule shall be substituted, namely:-

"(6) -Driving Test: Allotted Marks- 05 : The test shall be conducted only for those candidates, who claim in their applications that they are proficient in driving and possess either Light or Heavy Vehicle Driving Licence for the last Six Months (excluding learning period) or more from the date of advertisement of vacancies. The State Recruitment Board shall decide the modalities of conducting the driving test and may co-opt expert/experts from Transport Department. Those, who have the Light Vehicle Driving License and pass Light Vehicle Driving Test, shall be awarded 3 marks and those, having Heavy vehicle Driving License and pass Heavy vehicle driving Test, shall be awarded 5 marks. Those appearing for the test and awarded the marks shall be deemed to have accepted the service condition that, if called upon, they shall have to drive the Light or Heavy vehicle, as the case may be, as part of their normal duties and responsibilities. The Candidates having valid Driving License shall only be allowed to appear in the Driving Test. Candidate must produce the Original Driving License, which must tally with the details given by him in the Application form."

(f) for sub-rule,7the following rule shall be substituted namely:-

"(7) Educational achievements: Allotted Marks- 05

Minimum educational qualification shall be pass in High School Examination (Matriculation) or other equivalent examination.

	<u>Academic qualification</u>	<u>% of Marks</u>	<u>Marks</u>
(i)	Matriculation	60% and above	05
(ii)	Matriculation	less than 60%	No marks

Note: Marks shall be awarded only if the examination has been cleared in 1st attempt. No marks shall be awarded for higher academic qualifications".
