

POLICE CIRCULAR ORDER No. 143

Pooling and
maintenance
of
Government
vehicles.

In the light of the rules framed by the Government recently for regulating the control and use of the departmental vehicles under the above scheme, the Inspector-General of Police has been pleased to order that :—

(1) Use of the Police vehicles in the districts/establishments for private purpose should be totally forbidden henceforward.

(2) The case of an officer taking a Government vehicle to attend office should be regarded as private use.

(3) No officer utilising a departmental vehicle on tour may take his wife or family members but a servant or an orderly may be taken.

All are requested to observe the above instructions strictly
