

POLICE CIRCULAR ORDER No. 150

It has been brought to my notice that certain Gazetted Police Officers of this department have entered into transactions with private persons in the matter of sale and purchase of Cars without obtaining prior permission of the Government, in contravention of rule 15 of All-India Services (Conduct) Rules, 1954 and rule 21 of the Government Servants Conduct Rules (Orissa) and have approached this office subsequently to obtain *ex post facto* sanctions to regularise the transaction. This amounts to breach of mandatory rules for which Government have already taken serious view in some instances.

It is, therefore, impressed upon all Gazetted Officers of this department not to enter into any transaction of sale or purchase of car except through a regular reputed dealer without obtaining prior sanction of Government and any deviation there from will be seriously viewed in future.
