Instances have come to notice that District Superintendents of Police are sending all the correspondence to the C. I. D. Crime Branch ignoring their Range D. Is. G. So that a lot of difficulties are faced to get the views from the Range D. Is. G. All the correspondence to be made with C. I. D. Crime Branch should be routed through the Range D. Is. G. as C. I. D., Crime Branch is part of my office.

It is therefore ordered that in future all the correspondences should be routed through Range D. Is. G. But in case of urgent matter a copy of the letter may be sent to Crime Branch for reference. They may make the correspondence directly with S.P., C.I.D., C.B. when they are asked for by the S. P., C. I. D., C. B. In S. R. cases reports may continue to be sent directly.
