There is heavy pendency of N.B.Ws. in P.Ss. and O.Ps. One of the factors contributing to this heavy pendency is multiple issue of N.B.Ws., B.Ws., D.Ws. etc. against single warrantee. This has occurred mainly due to failure of the Os.I.C./Is. I.C.in intimating the courts issuing the warrants, in time, about the position regarding the execution of warrants. Multiple issue of N.B.Wa. can be avoided if concerned courts are intimated in time either regarding execution of warrants or about justification for further time required for execution. At times, there is accumulation of warrants against dead persons and against a warrantee who does not stay within the P.S./ O.P.limits. This can be avoided by timely intimation to the courts. Hence, to ensure that further warrants against the same warrantee are not issued by the courts, all the Is.I.C./Os.I.C. of the State are directed to intimate to the concerned courts regarding position of warrants in time, indicating there in the execution/non-execution of the same with reasons praying for further time for execution. Ss.P. of the Districts/ Establishments are instructed to monitor and exercise constant supervision to ensure prompt execution of warrants. Range D.Is.G. will look to the pending warrants during their inspections and visits to the Police Stations.
