POLICE CIRCULAR ORDER NO. 291/99

Special Police Squads for detection of trafficking of Liquor, Narcotic Substances and other Contraband goods:

Ref:- Instruction for Excise raids sent vide letter No.2573/Con. dated 9.6.95 and instruction against drug sent vide letter No.1423/Con. dated 23.2.99.

It is noticed that trafficking in illicit liquor, narastic substances and contraband goods are providing easy money to unemployed youths for which they are being attracted to the same and in the process they are getting involved in crimes and other nepharious activities which are threatening local law and order situation from time to time. It is absolutely necessary that trafficking in illicit liquor, narcotic substances and contraband goods which is proliferating in the urban areas of the state is stamped out through systematic actions. For the purpose, there shall be a Special Police Squad (SPS) by redistribution in each district consisting of one Inspector, one S.I., and four graduate constables being specially selected by the S.P. for the purpose. This Special Police Squad (SPS) should be provided with a jeep for their movement. The personnel posted to the Special Police Squad shall be rotated at the end of each month. The S.P. shall give specific target/task to be carried out on a daily basis by this Special Police Squad. The day to day detection made by the Special Squad should be reflected in the Daily Sitrep sent to State Police Headquarters. Besides, the S.P. should also consolidate the raids undertaken by the SPS during the month as per the format enclosed and send the same to the State Police Headquarters to be dealt in Con. Section by the 7th of the succeeding month.

Alockana Sabha that special rewards/encouragements and out of term promotion etc. will be considered by the competant authority. The S.P. shall ensure best results out of the raids conducted as well as rule out allegations of corruption/highhandedness against Special Police Squad through constant monitoring. The performance of Ss.P. will be assessed by the undersigned from time to time.

The Range D. I.Gs. are also to monitor the work of the Special Police Squad to maximise the impact on the increasing menace of the trafficking in illicit liquor, narcotics substances and other contraband goods.
