## POLICE CIRCULAR ORDER NO.310/2001.

Clause 9 of Police Order to.203 is substituted by the following provision:-

Police vehicles will normally be driven by Police Drivers assigned to the vehicles. Mowever, to meet the problem of acute shortage of Police drivers, APR/OR Constables in the Districts and Sepoys in the Battalions possessing valid driving licence and proficient in driving may be permitted by the respective Ss.P./Commandants to drive police vehicles. For this purpose a Board at the District and Battalion levels will check the validity of the driving licence and test the driving abilities of Constables/Sepoys of the concerned District/Battalion willing to drive vehicles and a panel will be prepared of those found suitable. These Constables/Sepoys will be allowed to drive police vehicles.

At the district level, the hoard will comprise the S.P. (Chairman), Dist. R.I. and a nominee of the DIG (PMT). At the En. level, the Loard will comprise the Commandant (Chairman), an Asst. commandant and a nominee of the DIG (PMT).

The Constables/Sepoys selected to drive police vehicles will not be entitled to any additional/special allowance but will be given preference, if they volunteer in due course, to get absorbed in the driving cadre.
