It is noticed that some Investigating Officers of the Orissa Police are not attending Court to depose evidence even after issue of repeated summons/mersages as well as directions from this Headquarters, resulting in unnecessary delay in the disposal of old cases. Adequate attention is also not being given by the concerned Heads of Office of the District/Establishments to this matter for which adverse comments/show cause notices are being received at this Headquarters from Judicial Courts.

It is, therefore, emphasised that the matter of Court attendance should be given top priority and summonees shall repeat shall attend Courts on the date fixed. The Controlling Officer shall be responsible for ensuring this.

Any deviation from the above order would be adversely viewed and departmental action should be initiated against chronic defaulters.
