POLICE CIRCULAR ORDER NO. 371 /2017

Sub:- Timely compliance of directions of Hon'ble Courts including High Court of Orissa and Supreme Court of India.

The Hon'ble High Court of Orissa vide order No. 13 dated 28.08.2017 passed in OJC No. 10160 of 2001 (Pravati Behera Vrs. State of Odisha & Others) has expressed sheer displeasure against police officers for repeated nonsubmission matter of the the Court order in compliance of PWC/instructions/case diaries etc. in time in the office of the Advocate General Odisha, Cuttack. Govt. in Home Department has observed that due to noncompliance of the directions/orders of the Hon'ble Court, disposal of cases are being delayed. It is made clear that on the event of non-compliance of order, appropriate proceeding under the Contempt of Courts Act shall be initiated against the erring officer by the Hon'ble High Court.

Hence, it is directed to issue suitable instructions to all police officers under your control to comply the directions of Hon'ble Supreme Court of India, High Court of Orissa and all other Courts in time without fail to avoid adverse remarks/orders.

Deviation of the instruction shall be viewed seriously and it is made imperative to take action against the erring officers.
