## POLICE CIRCULAR ORDER No. 61

I have come across several instances of continued indebtedness of many Police officers and men including even some officers holding superior gazetted posts. This brings a very bad name to the Department besides contravening Government Servants' Conduct Rules and Police Manual Rule 709 which clearly lays down that when a Police officer is adjudged or declared an insolvent, or when one moiety of his salary is constantly being attached, or has been continuously under attachment for a period exceeding two years or is attached for a sum which, in ordinary circumstance, can not be repaid within a period of two years, he will be liable to dismissal.

I take a very serious view of such continued indebtedness on the part of the Police officer and men and warn all concerned that in future such instances will be severly dealth with.
