

POLICE CIRCULAR ORDER No. 93

Unauthorised
removal of
electrical
fittings from
Government
buildings.

Instances have come to notice where electric installations have been removed from Government buildings without the authority of the Electrical Department. this unauthorised removal not only violates Electricity Rules but causes much difficulty for the Electricity Department in maintaining their records. Handling of electrical installations by non-technical personnel is also fraught with danger. In this connection the attention of all officers is drawn to the Government Order Communicated to you in this office Memo. No. 11462 (2)-BG., dated the 25th May 1953. It is hoped that all officers under your control should be strictly warned against such unauthorised removals and suitable action taken against those who violate the rules.
