

POLICE ORDER No. 33

Escort of
arms and
ammunition
from and to
Arsenals.

The Inspector-General directs that all consignments of 303 rifles, revolvers and their ammunition should further to be escorted for the sake of security.

Superintendents will send their own escorts direct to Arsenals and fix the strength of the escorts at their discretion.

The number of indents for arms and ammunition should be kept as low as possible and any arms for repair should be sent to the Arsenal through escort parties deputed to bring periodical supplies of ammunition.
