

POLICE ORDER No. 59

Inspection of motor vehicles involved in accidents. When a motor vehicle is involved in an accident and the Investigating Police Officer considers its examination by the Motor Vehicles Inspector necessary, he should immediately requisition his services and keep the vehicle in safe custody till the examination is over. If the Police Officer considers that the accident is not due to any mechanical defects of the vehicle, he may release the vehicle at his discretion and responsibility, but once the Motor Vehicle Inspector's services are requisitioned the vehicle should not be released before his inspection.

The opinion of a person other than the Motor Vehicle Inspector approved under the Motor Vehicle Rules should not be entertained.
