

POLICE CIRCULAR ORDER No. 3

An instance has recently come to the notice of the Inspector-General where, though several drill passed Constables were awaiting promotion, an unpassed Constable, who had twice officiated as a Town Outpost Havildar, was recommended for permanent promotion to the rank of Havildar of a Town Outpost on the ground that the drill passed men have no experience of Town Outpost work.
