

POLICE CIRCULAR ORDER No. 162

With a view to successfully tackle the question of evasion of M.V. Tax, two M.V.T. Amendment Acts, amendment Act 21 of 1962 on Madras M.V.T. Act and Amendment Act 23 of 1962 of B. & O.M.V.T. Act) have been enacted. The provisions made therein for seizure of untaxed vehicles and for imposition of penalty for non-payment of tax within 15 days from the due date are very effective ones. If Police Officers make use the legal provisions properly they will be able to curb the tendency of the owners to evade payments of Tax.

As these salutary provisions have not been made use of in several districts, I draw the attention of all the Officers to the same and request them to issue strict instructions to their subordinate officers in this regard separately. The result of action taken on this letter should also be included in the monthly report for "M.V.Tax".
