Submission of Quarterly and Monthly Crime Review

Quarterly/Monthly Crime Reviews prepared by Crime Branch contain a critical analysis of crime situation of the State. Such reviews are based on the analysis of crime situation furnished by the dist, Ss P./D.Cs.P./Ss.R.P. It is noticed that the manner and procedure adopted by the SsP/DCsP/Ss.R.P. in preparing Quarterly/ Monthly Crime Reviews differ from district to district. Some SsP furnish incomplete information, resulting in considerable difficulty in preparation of the State Crime Review. It is also seen that there is hardly any uniformity in the analysis or chronology of the topics. It is sometimes found that all the required annexures are not sent along with the Review.

2. Criminal Law (Amendment) Act, 2013 which came into effect on 3.2.2013 has made extensive amendment in Indian Penal Code and created large number of new offences. Comprehensive amendments have also been made in rape laws. These need to be reflected in the Crime Reviews. New areas of crime like Cyber Crime also need to be included in the Review.

- In order to bring about uniformity in the preparation of the Quarterly/Monthly Crime Reviews and to include new forms of crime, the following instructions are issued. A list of Statements to be enclosed with the Quarterly/Monthly Crime Review is attached herewith. The enclosures should be serially indicated in the forwarding letter of the Review and checked properly before submission.

- 4. The Review should commence with a paragraph regarding total cognizable cases. It is very important that reasons of fluctuation of crimes of the district are critically analyzed under this head. While reporting Total Cognizable case in the Quarterly Crime Review, it must be ensured that it tallies with the total reporting figures furnished in Monthly Crime Reviews of that quarter. If any discrepancy is noticed, the same should be reconciled and the discrepancy clarified.
- 5. After discussion of total cases, a certificate about compliance to the provision of sec.154 (2) Cr.P.C. should be furnished.
- 6. Crime under other heads (SI. No. II to XLV) should then be dealt with in the Review alongwith statements as per Proforma-II. In this part, each category of crime should be discussed, including the reasons for increase/ decrease, location of crime centers, preventive measures taken or contemplated. In case of continuous increase of any particular category of crime in a specific area, reasons thereof should be analyzed. In respect of murder, dacoity, robbery, rape, burglary/theft involving value of property of and above ₹ 5 lakhs, rioting leading to loss of life and cyber crime, a brief description of the offence may be given. If any of the cases are Special Report cases, reference of SR number should be furnished.

- 7. In respect of cases under Essential Commodities Act, NDPS Act, Gambling Act and Excise Act, quantities of contraband seized should be reflected.
- 8. As regards other statement to be enclosed with the Quarterly/Monthly Crime Review, a list is attached herewith.
- 9. When observations are made by DGP/ADGP/IGP, on reviews of districts, compliance note should be sent by S.P. himself within 15 days of the communication of observations/remarks.
- 10. Quarterly/Monthly Crime Review should be sent by 12<sup>th</sup> of the following month.
- 11. The instant revised instructions and proformas shall be used in the Monthly Review of June, 2013 and Crime Review of 2<sup>nd</sup> Quarter of 2013 onwards.
