

POLICE CIRCULAR ORDER No. 55

Your attention is invited to this office letter No. 21839 (24)-F., dated the 23rd November 1951. Instances are frequent in which heads of offices are failing to submit applications in the prescribed form with all the required information. This leads to needless correspondence and increase of work all round. It should be noted that no application for house rent will be entertained henceforward unless submitted in the proper form. The Superintendents of Police are requested to make their 2nd clerk/Accountant responsible for this, so that if any application is turned down on the above ground, the clerk concerned will make good the house rent to the claimant in question.
