The standards of investigation and supervision need stepping up as latches in investigation has led to several adverse comments from the Sessions Judges, Supervising officers should realise their responsibility regarding scrutiny of the action taken by the investigating officers and prompt rectification of defects. circle Officers and Gazetted officers, who receive copies of case diaries should study them thoroughly and rectify defects.
